# About Jeonju

Jeonju is the capital and largest city of Jeollabuk-do, South Korea. It is both urban and rural due to the closeness of Wanju County which almost surrounds Jeonju. The name Jeonju literally means "Perfect Region". It is an important tourist center famous for Korean food, historic buildings, sports activities, and innovative festivals. Jeonju has best maintained the Korean traditions and culture through hanok (Korean traditional houses), hansik (Korean traditional cuisine) and hanji (Korean traditional paper) as well as pansori, a Korean traditional genre of musical storytelling performance, which was designated as a Masterpiece of the Oral and Intangible Heritage of Humanity by UNESCO in 2003.

In May 2012, Jeonju was chosen as a Creative City for Gastronomy as part of UNESCO's Creative Cities Network. This honor recognizes the city's traditional home cooking handed down over thousands of years, its active public and private food research, a system of nurturing talented chefs, and its hosting of distinctive food festivals.

### Local currency and exchange rate

The local currency of Korea is Korean Won (KRW Symbol: ₩). The exchange rate as of August 1, 2023 is USD 1 to KRW 1,279.00. Paper money comes in denominations of 1,000; 5,000; 10,000; and 50,000 won bills. Coins come in 1, 5, 10, 100, and 500 won (1, 5, and 10 won coins are not widely circulated).

# **Exchanging currency**

Foreign currency exchange can be done at banks, money changers, or hotels.

### Climate


Korea lies in a temperate zone with four distinct seasons. The temperatures in Jeonju in September range from 16°C to 25°C.


### **Dress code**

### **Electricity**

The standard voltage throughout Korea is normally 220 V, 60 Hz. Most power plugs and sockets in Korea are type C and type F.
